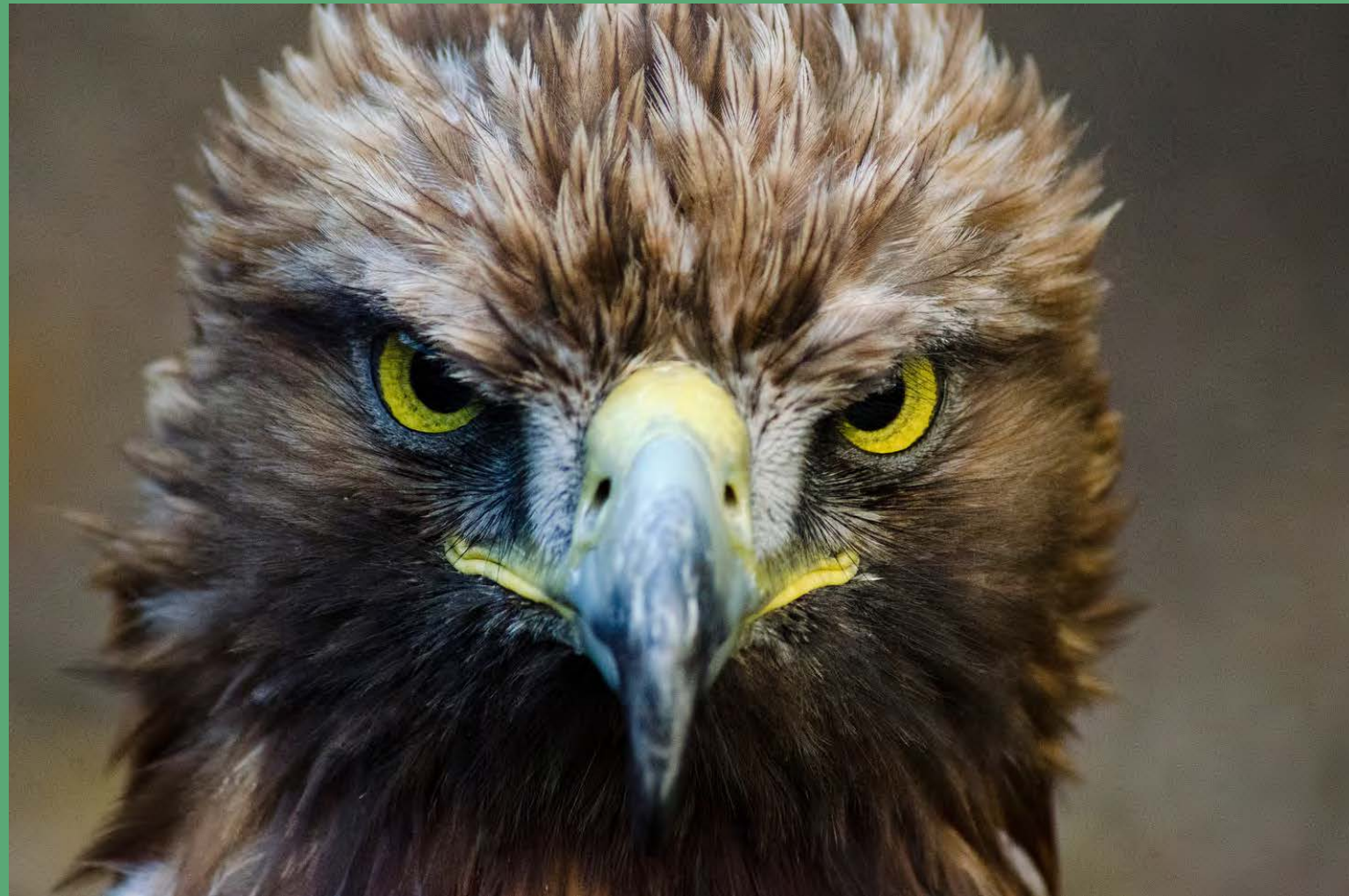
National Bird
